



TAYLER MALSAM: Career Highlights

2010

- Joined Kyle Busch Motorsports as driver of the No. 56 Toyota Tundra in the NASCAR Camping World Truck Series.

2009

- Notched one top-five and 10 top-10 finishes driving the full Truck Series season for Randy Moss Motorsports.
- Best start was fifth at Iowa Speedway in Newton in July and best finish was fifth at Gateway International Raceway near St. Louis the very next weekend.

2008

- Competed full-time in the 2008 ARCA RE/MAX Series as a development driver for Penske Racing.
- Broke into the ARCA top-10 in points at Rockingham (N.C.) Speedway and remained there for the final 17 races of the season, placing ninth in the final standings.
- Scored third-place finishes at Pocono (Pa.) Raceway and New Jersey Motorsports Park in Millville and a fifth-place finish on the dirt oval at Springfield, Ill.
- Made Truck Series debut in August at Bristol (Tenn.) Motor Speedway driving the No. 41 Thunderboats Dodge for owner Carl Hartman.
- Made his second Truck Series start for Bill Davis Racing in the season finale at Homestead-Miami Speedway, where he started 22nd and finished 21st.

2007

- Made his ARCA RE/MAX Series debut at Toledo, Ohio, driving for owner Mark Gibson. Started eighth and finished 33rd.
- Competed in Late Model stock cars at Irwindale (Calif.) Raceway.
- Set fastest qualifying lap for a rookie during time trials for 47th annual Knoxville (Iowa) Nationals (15.044 seconds around the dirt, half-mile oval).

2006

- Competed for a full season in the Formula TR open-wheel road racing series.
- Also competed in 360 and 410 Winged Sprint cars throughout the year, advancing to the Knoxville Nationals.

2005

- Began racing shifter karts at age 15. Qualified for the U.S. Nationals.
